

ST. JUDE PARISH PRESCHOOL

PROGRAMS:

Classes will begin August 28, 2017 and will follow the St. Jude School calendar.

School hours: Morning Preschool – Drop-off 8:50 am – 9:00 am and Pick-up 11:25 am.

Afternoon Preschool – Drop-off 12:40 pm – 12:50 pm and Pick-up 3:15 pm.

Daycare Before or After Preschool (Information enclosed)

2 year olds:

- 2 day program – Tuesday & Thursday – 9:00 am – 11:00 am
- Must be age 2 on or before September 1st
- Guardian must be available during class hours if needed for diapering

3 year olds: must be toilet trained

- 3 day program – Monday, Wednesday, Friday
- Must be age 3 on or before September 1st

4 year olds:

- 5 day program – Monday – Friday
- Must be age 4 on or before September 1st

2 year old program - \$1,350

3 year old program - \$1,900

4 year old program - \$3,200

- \$100 per child (10 raffle tickets)

Please note: There is a one-time, non-refundable \$50 processing fee for **new** families, along with a \$100 registration fee. The \$100 registration fee is deducted from your tuition total. There is no discount given for paying preschool tuition in full.

CURRICULUM

The preschool program features a creative curriculum infused with traditional learning methods. This allows the lessons to be presented in a multitude of ways to incorporate various learning styles. Lessons will be taught to students independently, as well as in a small and large group setting. Team teaching is another method we will be using. This allows our 3 and 4 year olds to interact for certain lessons such as art and music.

The focus of our 2 year old program is to encourage socialization while acclimating students to a school environment. The curriculum emphasizes play and creativity.

The preschool students will also be included in the larger St. Jude School Community throughout the year including prayer families, consisting of 1 or 2 students from each class throughout the school, lead by a teacher. Families may work on a variety of projects that promote community awareness or spiritual growth.

CLASS SIZES:

Classes will be limited to 16 students per class. Classes will be taught by certified, licensed teachers. There will also be a learning/resource aide in the classrooms.

A mixed classroom environment can occur depending on enrollment.
