

ST. JUDE SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Car Rider Arrival – Students arriving by car will use Second Avenue and the north Church parking lot. Cars may form a line *up to the Church doors* and wait for a supervisor to direct students into the *Church narthex and through the north school doors*. Students may begin entering at 8:55 a.m. The doors will be locked at 9:05 a.m. Students arriving after 9:05 must enter through the *Main School entrance* and stop at the office for a tardy slip before proceeding to class.

Car Rider Dismissal – Children with last names beginning with the letters **A-J** will be dismissed through the north parking lot (in front of the Church) and cars should exit down Second Avenue. Please form a line and fill in all spaces hugging the perimeter of the lot. A teacher will direct children to their cars as they reach the front of the line. Please allow the right-of-way for cars coming and going to the Church.

Children with last names beginning with **K-Z** will be dismissed from the west entrance (gym). Please enter and exit using Third Street. Teachers will direct students to cars as they reach the front of the line. Please allow the right-of-way for cars coming and going from the Parish office.

Bus Rider Arrival – Buses will use Third Avenue and students will be dropped off in the West parking lot. A teacher will be present to direct students into the building.

Bus Rider Dismissal – Bus riders will be dismissed at 3:25 p.m. from the Church doors to the buses in the Southeast parking lot.

Walkers - Students who walk to school may enter through the doors nearest the Parish office and walk in with the car riders from 8:55 – 9:05 a.m. They will be considered tardy if arriving after 9:05 a.m. After 9:05, they must enter through the Main School entrance.

After school, walkers will be escorted by a teacher out of the school doors nearest the Parish Office.

Please be reminded that it is against *Illinois State Law* to pass a school bus with the STOP ARM extended, anywhere, including school property. IT IS ALSO AGAINST ILLINOIS STATE LAW TO BE USING A CELL PHONE (TALKING OR TEXTING) WHILE DRIVING ON SCHOOL/CHURCH PROPERTY.
